

Targets and Topic information



Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back to the summer term. We hope you've had a relaxing and enjoyable break. The children have returned ready to learn and have settled into the new routines well. They have all welcomed Mr Khan to our school and have enjoyed getting to know him as he has been in and out visiting the children. It seems hard to believe that we are in the summer term already. We are amazed at how well the children are progressing and are really proud of their achievements so far.

Just a few reminders:

Children must bring their book bag into school daily. Please ensure that in it they have their reading book and reading record. Most books will be changed once a week. Please continue to read with your child at home. If you want to change their book any other time please do. Please also remember to complete a dinner slip for your child at the beginning of each week. Can I also remind you to ensure your child has a water bottle- especially as the weather will be getting warmer! Your child will need a sun hat too!

Please make sure your child always has their PE kit in school and that **all** items are labelled. PE days are **Tuesday** and **Friday**. Please provide your child with an indoor and outdoor kit that is clearly named.

Homework

Homework will continue to be set on a Friday and due for return the following Wednesday. We do have the Year 1 phonics screening check in June so there may be some additional phonics homework. This phonics screening check is a nationwide reading

assessment that checks the children's ability to segment and blend words containing the phonemes (sounds) they have been taught. We will send home more information about this nearer the time.

Forest Schools

We are very lucky that our class have Forest Schools during the summer term. The sessions run on Wednesday and Thursday afternoon and the class will be split into 2 groups. Please provide your child with suitable clothing and footwear for their Forest School session.

Please find enclosed the topic web for this term. I hope this has provided some insight into what the children will be learning. And finally, if you're concerned about anything at all please do come and talk to one of us.
