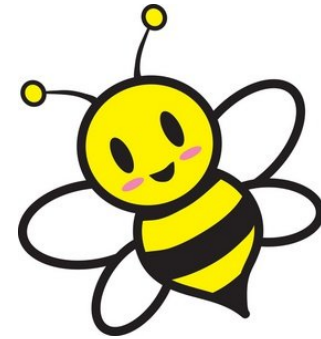

Dear Mums, Dads and Carers,

Welcome to the summer term! I hope you all had great Easter holiday and are looking forward to the final term of year 5 which includes the Whitwell residential: a highlight for all upper Key Stage 2 children. We had a fantastic spring term and would like to thank you again for your continued support of our school and your child's education.

Please find enclosed the topic web for the summer term and below is the information that you will need to help support your child at home:

Read with your child at home and discuss books that they are interested in as often as possible, encouraging them to delve in a mixture of fiction and non-fiction. Please ensure your child has their homework diary and reading book in school every day.

Please make sure your child has their PE kit in school every day (as timetables change with the weather!) and that all items are labelled and clean. PE days are Monday and Friday this term, but we will be resuming our mile a day, so children will need some suitable footwear to run in on a daily basis. It is important to make sure your child has a named water bottle in school too, especially now that it is getting hot and they are likely to get dehydrated quicker.

Visit the school's website for any other information, since in a bid to more green we are ensuring as much up to date information as possible is up there.

Your child will be given literacy and maths homework in their activity books which will be sent home on Fridays highlighted with the relevant page to complete, related to their learning in class that week. These will need to be returned the following Wednesday. In addition to this your child will receive activities and practice related to the weekly spelling blend focus, which will also need completing by the Wednesday.

**Your child has their individual targets in subject books.  
The class has a focus target for each subject, details of these are below:**

**Numeracy:**

To develop addition, subtraction, multiplication and division knowledge to include working with larger numbers and decimals.

**Literacy – Writing:**

To edit and review, changing grammar and vocabulary when appropriate to suit the purpose and audience of my writing. To use a range of more complex sentences to include varied punctuation.

**Literacy – Reading:**

To analyse how messages, moods, feelings and attitudes are conveyed, making reference to the text and lifting out evidence.
