<p><b>Maths:</b> Place Value Review; Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division; Measure and Fractions.</p>	<p><b>English:</b> Information Texts (linked to Science); Tales; Letters and Instructions. <b>Guided Reading</b> Selected fiction and non-fiction texts linked to the above.</p>	<p><b>RE:</b> Enquiry – What happens in the daily life of a Christian?</p>
<p><b>Science:</b> Living Things and Their Habitats; Animals Including Humans.</p>	<p><b>Geography:</b> Our World – The 7 Continents and 5 Oceans.</p>	<p><b>PSHE:</b> Forest Schools, Circle Time</p>

The above gives you an outline of what we will be learning across this term. This list is not exhaustive, and learning is adapted to all our children's abilities and interests.

<p><b>Belongings</b> – please remember to send your child in with <b>named</b> belongings, including a <b>water bottle</b> for daily use and clothing to suit the weather.</p> <p><b>PE</b> – will continue to be on <b>Mondays</b> and <b>Thursdays</b> so children will need to come into school in their PE kits on these days.</p> <p><b>Forest Schools</b> – our class now have Forest Schools on a <b>Tuesday</b>, so please make sure your child has a separate bag for their wellies and coats on this day.</p> <p>Book bags – the children will need to have their <b>reading books</b> and reading records school <b>every day</b>. Please ensure you check this daily for any 'Just to let you know' notes.</p>	<p>The children will continue to be <b>set</b> homework on a <b>Friday</b>, which is <b>due</b> in the following <b>Wednesday</b>.</p> <p>Their homework will include weekly <b>spellings</b> and a piece of maths, phonics, English or other piece of work linked to their learning.</p> <p>They will also be expected to <b>read several times a week</b>. Please help them to do this at home and let us know how they are getting on in their reading records. This is a crucial part of their learning – thank you for your continued help with this.</p>
