This term's learning

<p><b>Maths:</b> Problem solving with all four operations; types of measure; fractions; time.</p>	<p><b>Guided Reading</b> Class reader – The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark. <b>English:</b> Stories, linked to our class reader. Leaflets and newspaper reports.</p>	<p><b>RE:</b> Enquiry – How do people decide what is right and wrong? What do religious people believe about God?</p>
<p><b>Science:</b> Animals, Including Humans. Plants.</p>	<p><b>Geography:</b> Brilliant Britain – London. <b>History:</b> The Great Fire of London.</p>	<p><b>PSHE:</b> Votes for Schools, Circle Time.</p>
<p><b>Computing</b> Data handling – collecting, sorting and presenting data.</p>	<p><b>DT/Art:</b> Painting (colour mixing). Printing</p>	<p><b>PE:</b> Fitness; athletics; striking and fielding games; net and wall games.</p>

The above gives you an outline of what we will be learning across this term. This list is not exhaustive, and learning is adapted to all our children's abilities and interests.

Things to remember ...	Homework
<p><b>Belongings</b> – please remember to send your child in with <b>named</b> belongings, including a <b>water bottle</b> for daily use and clothing to suit the weather. Sun cream applied before school and hats may come in useful soon too...</p> <p><b>PE</b> – will continue to be on <b>Mondays</b> and <b>Thursdays</b> so children will need to come into school in their PE kits on these days.</p> <p>Book bags – the children will need to have their <b>reading books</b> and reading records in school <b>every day</b>. Please ensure you check this daily for any 'Just to let you know' notes.</p>	<p>The children will continue to be <b>set</b> homework on a <b>Friday</b>, which is <b>due</b> in the following <b>Wednesday</b>.</p> <p>Their homework will include weekly <b>spellings</b> and a piece of maths, English or other piece of work linked to their learning.</p> <p>They will also be expected to <b>read several times a week</b>. Please help them to do this at home and let us know how they are getting on in their reading records. This is a crucial part of their learning – thank you for your continued help with this.</p>
